**ORDER EXTENDING DEADLINES APPLICABLE TO UNITED STATES  
GOVERNMENTAL UNITS DURING GOVERNMENT SHUT DOWN**

This matter came before the Court *sua sponte*. The Court FINDS that due to the “shut down” of the United States government effective midnight, E.D.T., on September 30, 2013, many federal governmental units may be temporarily unable to meet pending deadlines in bankruptcy cases, contested matters, and/or adversary proceedings before the Court;


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that, to the extent authorized under the Bankruptcy Code (“Code”); the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure (“Rules”); or the New Mexico Local Bankruptcy Rules (“Local Rules”):

- Any and all deadlines imposed by the Code, the Rules, the Local Rules, or by an order of this Court that apply to a governmental unit of the United States, including the Office of the United States Trustee, are extended only as to governmental units of the United States and the United States Trustee, by the same number of business days the United States government is shut down, unless the Court orders otherwise upon a finding of compelling circumstances;
- Fed.R.Civ.P. 9006(f) applies with respect to computation of the extended deadlines under this Order;
- Trials and hearings scheduled during the period that the United States government is shut down will be continued only by order of the Court, which orders may be entered *sua sponte*, with notice to Steven Yarbrough, the Acting United States Attorney, and to Michael H. Hoses;

The next business day after the government shut down ends, the Court will enter a supplemental order terminating the extension and specifying the number of days deadlines were extended by this Order.

This Order is subject to modification or amendment should circumstances so warrant.
