R. Bankr. P. 9011. Each attorney, law firm, trustee or other person that obtains a password for electronic filing is responsible for the account security and use. No attorney, law firm, trustee or other person may knowingly permit or cause to permit an electronic filer's password to be utilized by anyone other than an authorized member, employee or agent of the electronic filer's firm.</p>
