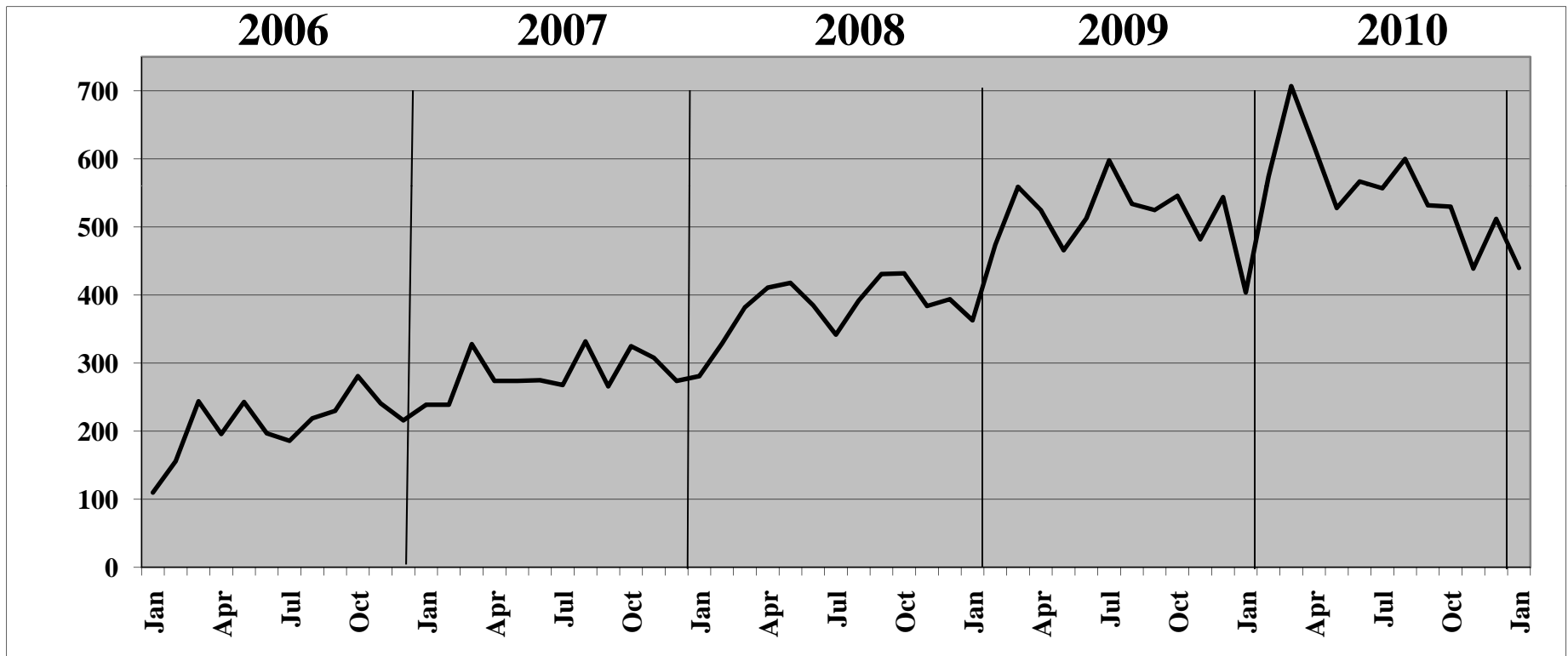

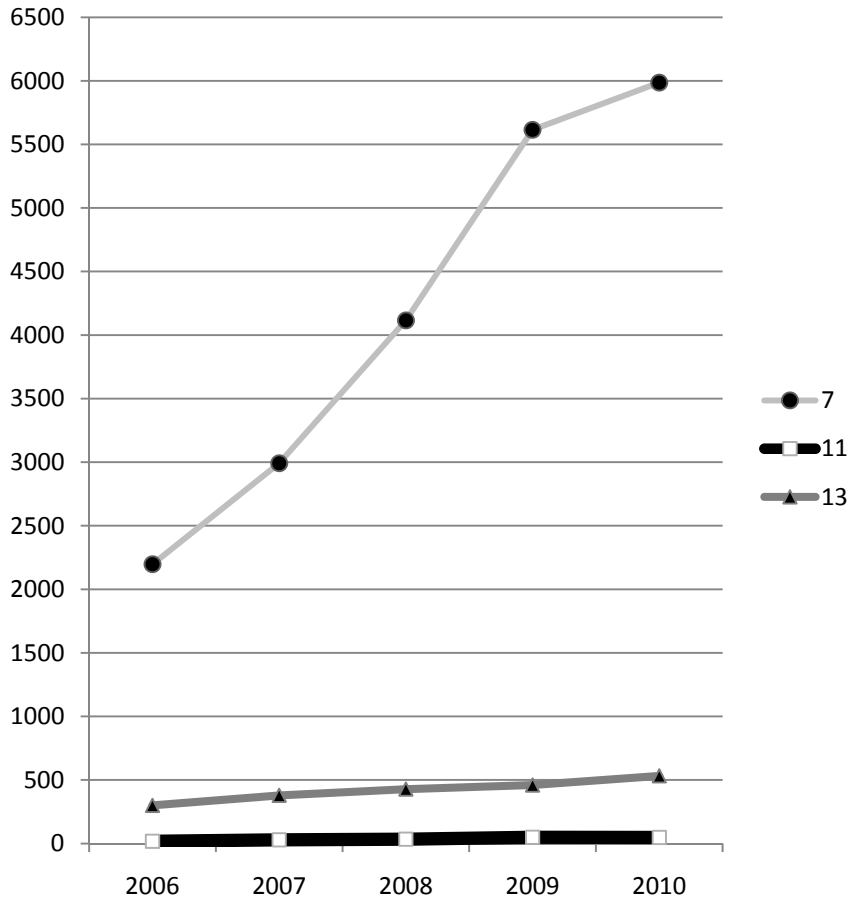

New Mexico Bankruptcy Filings Jan 2006 – Jan 2011



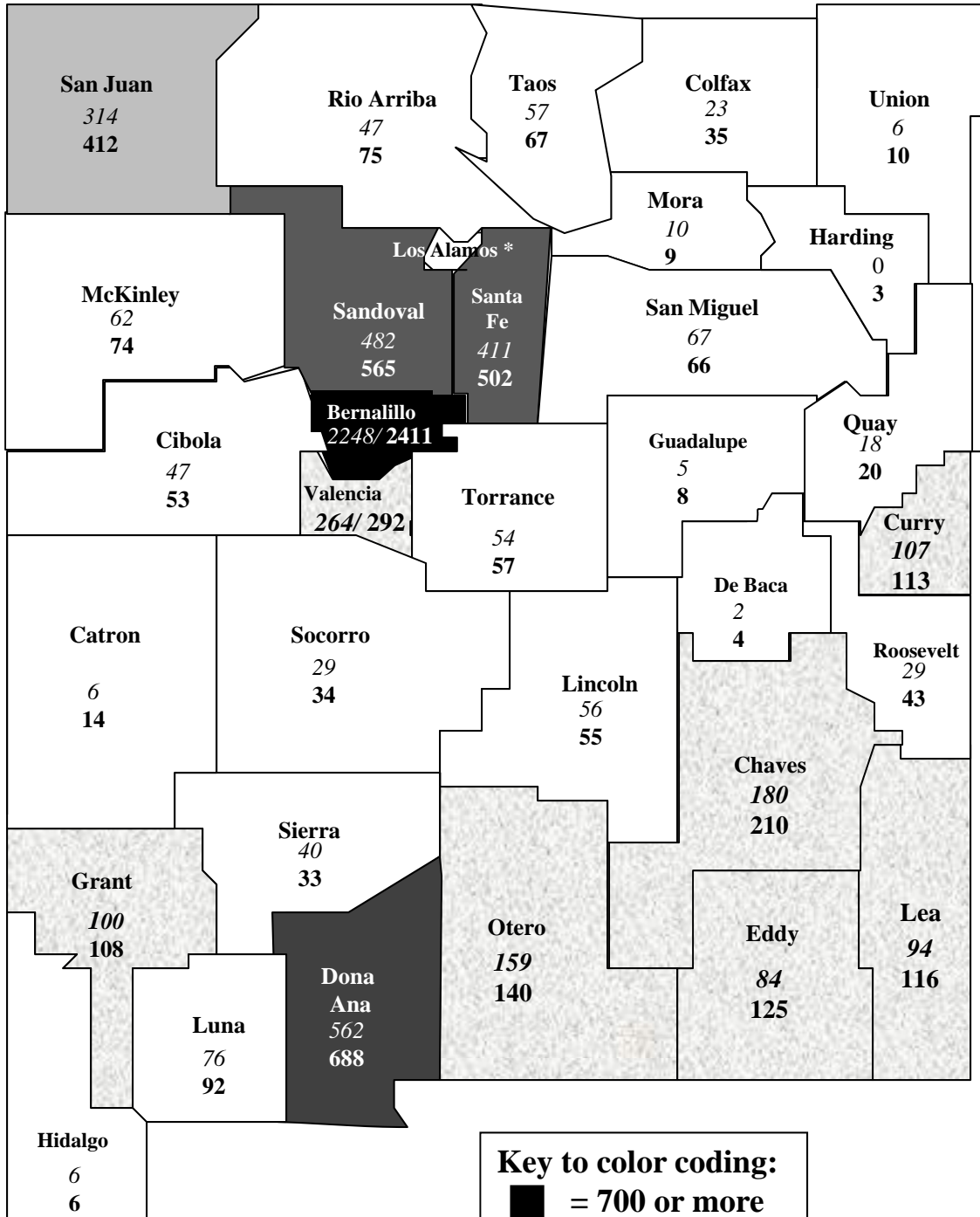
District of New Mexico Bankruptcy Filing Trends

- = < than 100

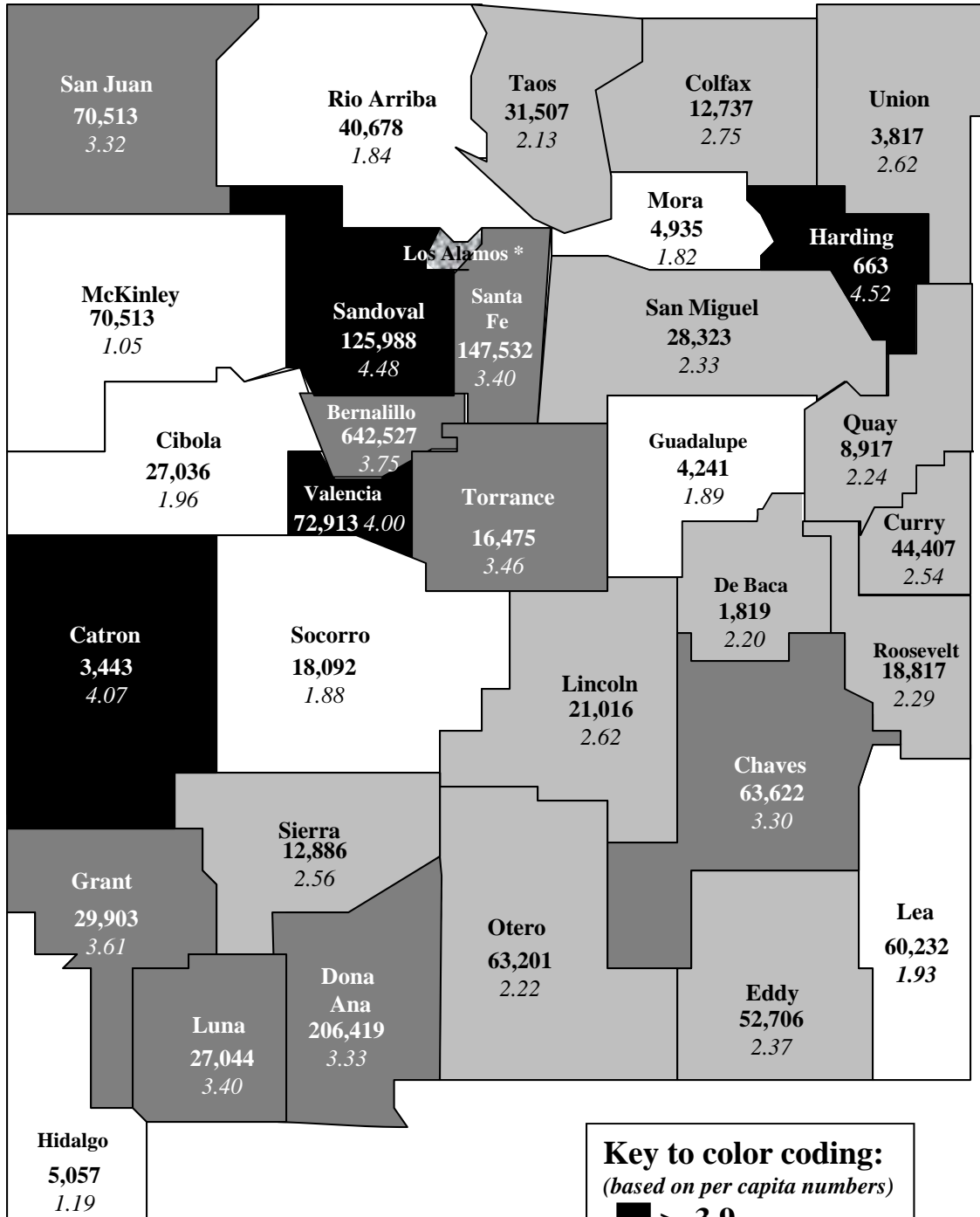

- **CM-ECF v.4.1**
 - ▶ Probably go live early this summer
 - ▶ Changes for public users:
 - ✓ Filing “agents”
 - ✓ Enhanced options for sealed cases/documents/entries
 - ✓ Revised claims module
 - ✓ Access to older cases restricted (privacy)
 - ✓ BNC enhancements
 - ✓ E-Orders enabled; pilot project probable
- **Chat Line**
- **Audio of Court Hearings on PACER**
- **Pro Se Pathfinder Beta**

Other Information

Please,

- Proof your PDF files before you electronically file them
- Particularly true for the petition document. Without a petition and signature page, there is no case
- When filing a new bankruptcy, proof your data entry before submitting it
- Remember to redact private information before electronically filing pleadings
