

**TEMPORARY ASSIGNMENT OF BANKRUPTCY JUDGES
FOR SERVICE OUTSIDE THEIR APPOINTED DISTRICTS
WITHIN THE TENTH CIRCUIT**

Pursuant to the provisions of Title 28, United States Code § 155(a) and the Judicial Council Plan for Temporary Transfer of Bankruptcy Judges adopted October 27, 1997, I hereby temporarily assign the following United States Bankruptcy Judges in the Tenth Circuit to hold bankruptcy court in the districts listed opposite their names, on an “as needed” basis.
