**MOTION BY INDIVIDUAL DEBTOR
FOR DETERMINATION THAT DEBTOR IS UNABLE
TO COMPLETE REQUIREMENTS FOR BUDGET AND CREDIT COUNSELING**

- Active military duty in a military combat zone.**
