NOTICE OF DEADLINE TO OBJECT TO CHAPTER 13 PLAN

If you object to confirmation of the plan, you must file an objection within **21 days** of the date of service of this notice. Objections must be filed with the Bankruptcy Court Clerk, P.O. Box 546, Albuquerque, NM 87103-0546. Copies must be served on debtor's attorney (name and address below) and the chapter 13 trustee, Tiffany M. Cornejo, 625 Silver Avenue SW, Suite 350, Albuquerque, NM 87102. If you are an attorney, you must file the objection electronically.

If no objections are timely filed, the Court may enter an order confirming the plan without a hearing. If any objections are timely filed, the Court will hold a preliminary hearing on _____, 20___, at _____ a.m./p.m., in the Court's hearing room, 13th floor of the Dennis Chavez Federal Building and United States Courthouse, 500 Gold Avenue SW, Albuquerque, New Mexico. Counsel/parties may appear by telephone by making arrangements with chambers at least one business day before the hearing. For Judge Jacobvitz's cases, call 505-348-2545 or email jacobvitzstaff@nmcourt.fed.us. For Judge Thuma's cases, call 505-348-2420 or email thumastaff@nmcourt.fed.us. Email requests to appear by telephone must contain your name and telephone number, the debtor's name and case number, and the date and time of the hearing.
