ORDER ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO LOCAL RULES, NEW LOCAL RULES, AND LOCAL FORM CHAPTER 13 PLAN

On April 3, 2017, the Court published for public comment a proposed mandatory local form Chapter 13 plan and proposed amendments to the Local Rules of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of New Mexico. Comments were received and reviewed. On September 22, 2017, the Court published for public comment proposed additional amendments to the Local Rules of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of New Mexico. Comments were received and reviewed.

WHEREFORE, in accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 2071, Fed.R.Civ.P. 92, Fed.R.Bankr.P. 9029, and Administrative Order No. 84-0324 of the United States District Court for the District of New Mexico authorizing the Bankruptcy Court to make local rules governing practice and procedure in bankruptcy cases and adversary proceedings in this district,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that amendments to NM LBR 1005-1, NM LBR 3015-2(c), (d) and (e), and NM LBR 9013-1; new NM LBR 2016-1(b), new NM LBR 3015-2(a), new NM LBR 3021-1, new NM LBR 6004-1, and new 7016-1(a); and NM LF 3015-2 (Chapter 13 Plan), are hereby adopted effective December 1, 2017.

ORDERED FURTHER, that the amendments, new local rules, and local form Chapter 13 plan adopted by this Order have an effective date of December 1, 2017 and will apply to all cases and adversary proceedings commenced on or after the effective date, and all cases and adversary proceedings then pending insofar as just and practicable, unless the Court orders otherwise.²
