
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

President Trump has declared Wednesday, December 5, 2018, a National Day of Mourning to honor the memory of former President George H.W. Bush. Following the lead of the executive branch, the Supreme Court will be in recess, the Administrative Office will be closed, the United States District Court for the District of New Mexico will be closed, and this Court will be closed. To the extent that time sensitive hearings are scheduled, the presiding bankruptcy judge will determine how those will proceed.

The President's Executive Order declares that December 5, 2018, will be treated as a holiday for federal leave purposes.
